AND GOD SAYS

On Maple Rd., in Black River Falls, there is a warning sign that I noticed a short time ago and has had me perplexed as to its meaning. The sign is regulatory sign depicting the rear view of an Amish buggy. Superimposed on it is a red circle with a diagonal line through it. When I first saw it, I was passed it before I saw its detail. I went away asking myself, what was being prohibited. My first thought was, "Does it really mean that no Amish buggies are allowed on this road? But that seemed unreasonable because there are several Amish families that use that road to get to and from their homes.

I just didn't understand its message.

I continued to ask people, especially Amish people, what that sign meant. The first one didn't know either. Another said it meant "no tipping." He said he thought that because one sign was higher than the other. I still wasn't satisfied with the answers I had received, so I asked another. He said it means "no driving the buggy on the shoulder of the road." He tried to explain it to me, but I still wasn't convinced. If that is what it means, why put the sign where there is no shoulder to drive on?

So I stopped and took a closer look at the sign. And sure enough, it did picture one wheel on the pavement and the other on the shoulder. I never even noticed this, even after seeing the sign several times. But, after examining it more closely, I now believe that is what it means. But I guess it is all right for cars, trucks or tractors to do so, as the sign is specific to Amish buggies. But that is not my point.

The point I want to make is that I viewed the sign the way a lot of people look at Scripture— they glance at it in a hurry as their time is valuable, they listen to it causally because they have more important things on their mind, and they are too busy to go back and really check it out to learn what it all really means. Furthermore, even though I went back and looked at it several more times, I missed its real meaning until it was explained to me by someone who knew more that I. That is called "revelation." That is what the Bible is. It is God's revelation to us. It explains the meaning of Jesus birth and death. It reveals God's nature to us—that He loved us enough to purposely send His Son to become a man so He could die for us (Romans 5:8). But it reveals so much more. Why not stop and take another closer look at God's Word and give it a moment of your undivided attention? You might be surprised what God might reveal to you.



Plowing Snow/Ice onto Highways

This winter, as usual, both county plows and local homeowners will be out trying to clear away snow as quickly as possible after the storm ends. Just as certain as the storms that will come is the fact that some homeowners will be displeased because we have plowed their already-cleared driveways full of snow again.

We wish we could leave each driveway meticulously clear, but doing so would mean we could never finish plowing the highways in a reasonable time. We also wish to remind everyone that depositiong the snow/ice you remove from your driveway onto a highway or highway shoulders is not only dangerous, but illegal. Wisconsin Statute, "Rules of the Road", 346.94(5), "Placing Injurious Substance on Highway. No person shall place or cause to be placed upon on highway any foreign substance which is or may be injurious to any vehicle or part thereof." Wis St. 346.95(3) "Any person violating s.346.925 or a s.346.94(5) or (14) shall be required to forfeit \$50 for each offense."

Please help us keep our highways safe; do not deposit any snow/ice from your driveway onto any road or highway.


