

Truth Matters

The foundational problem with the innuendo and falsehoods spread by Jake's opponent is that it shows the opponent's level of integrity, investigation, and ability to analyze issues. Clark County deserves much better than being sold false fears. ELIGIBILITY

Individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence.



Shelter

Homeless shelters, domestic violence shelters, transitional housing, etc.



Hotels/Motels

Staying in motels/hotels due to lack of adequate alternatives.



Staying with Others

Staying with other people due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reason.



Unsheltered

Staying in a car, park, public space, abandoned building, substandard housing, or similar settings.

STUDENT RIGHTS

Immediate Enrollment

Even without proof of residency, quardianship, immunizations, or school records.

School Choice

Students may choose to stay at the school they attended when permanently housed or to enroll in the school district where they are currently living for the remainder of the academic year. Families have the right to dispute a decision made by the district.

Free Meals

Students are automatically eligible to receive free lunch for the duration of the school year.

Fee Waiver

Required school/course fees will be waived. Laptop insurance is also provided free of charge.

Transportation

Transportation is provided for students residing outside of their school's attendance area.


SCHOOL DISTRICT OF NEILL ANNUAL NOTICE OF SPECIAL **EDUCATION REFERRAL AND EVALUATION PROCEDURES**

Upon request, the School District of Neillsville is required to evaluate a child for eligibility for special education services. A request for evaluation is known as a referral. When the district receives a referral, the district will appoint an Individualized Education Program (IEP) team to determine if the child has a disability, and if the child needs special education services. The district locates, identifies, and evaluates all children with disabilities who are enrolled by their parents in private (including religious) schools, elementary schools and secondary schools located in the school district.

A physician, nurse, psychologist, social worker, or administrator of a social agency who reasonably believes a child brought to him or her for services is a child with a disability has a legal duty to refer the child, including a homeless child, to the school district in which the child resides. Before referring the child, the person making the referral must inform the child's parent that the referral will be made.

Others, including parents, who reasonably believe a child is a child with a disability may also refer the child, including a homeless child, to the school district in which the child resides.

Referrals must be in writing and include the reason why the person believes the child is a child with a disability. A referral may be made by contacting Austin Hiess, Director of Special Education, School District of Neillsville at 715-743-8716 or by writing him at ahiess@neillsvillek12.org.



Dux and Hoffmann made their fourth appearance at the WIAA state tournament. They are only the third and fourth (respectively) wrestlers in Neillsville history to do so.




