This thinking legislates itself into a free society, where criminals are taken off the streets for their crimes, and where freedoms are enjoyed by those willing to control themselves (i.e. America before the sixties).

“Humanism propounds that man is inherently good. Inanimate objects (guns & knives) and circumstances (poverty) are believed to be the cause for the evil that is perpetrated rather than the perpetrator. Therefore, since man is not accountable for his own actions, his actions must be controlled. This results in controlled societies where freedoms are greatly restricted. They are also societies with much crime because ‘victim criminals’ are continually turned loose after short incarcerations because their bad behavior wasn’t really their fault” (Italics mine).

It is no accident that the more we, as a nation, move away from God, the more crime escalates. Thus, the more controlling our government must become to control the crime, resulting in our loss of our freedoms.

So my question to you is, “Which government would you rather have rule over you— the one with a Christian worldview (as in early America) or the one with the humanist worldview (as in socialist/Communist countries)? America is at a crossroads right now and we must quickly decide which we want. Will we turn back to God or continue in our foolishness? For God says. “. . . although they knew God, they did not glorify him as God, nor were they thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.” (Romans 1:21, Italics mine). The answer to our foolish and failing society is not more government but turning back to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (see 2 Chronicles 7:14).


