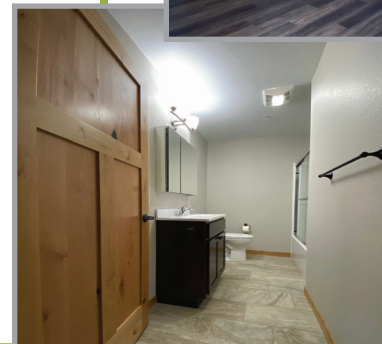

**AND GOD SAYS . . .**

God's Word reveals to us that a one-world government will be established and the one who will rule, called the Antichrist, will deceive many to take his mark upon their hand or forehead. And if he can't deceive them, he will then force them to take it by preventing them from buying or selling without it. It is without question that we are very close to this prophecy coming true.
