Florida’s tourism chief, Bryan Griffin, recently turned down an invitation from the World Economic Forum to their upcoming Urban Transportation Summit in San Francisco. Apparently his response to their invitation is virtually unheard of especially for the reasons he cited.

According to Alex Nitzberg’s report on Fox News, October 3, 2025, Griffin wrote back to the globalist organization stating, “I’m going to decline participation. The World Economic Forum’s values and stated objectives do not align with the State of Florida, including the WEF’s efforts to transform society through top-down government regulations and institute dangerous programs like digital IDs and Centralized Bank Digital Currencies [CBDC].”

It seems to me, that never before in all of history has there been such a mechanism in place to realistically provide for this prophecy to be fulfilled. 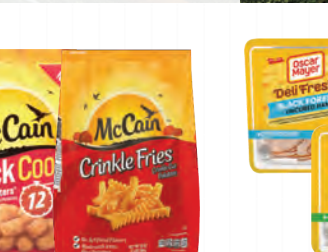

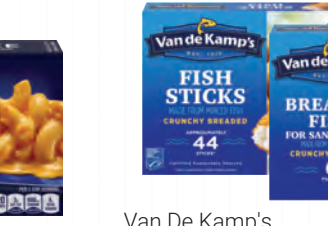

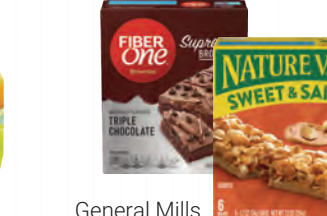
