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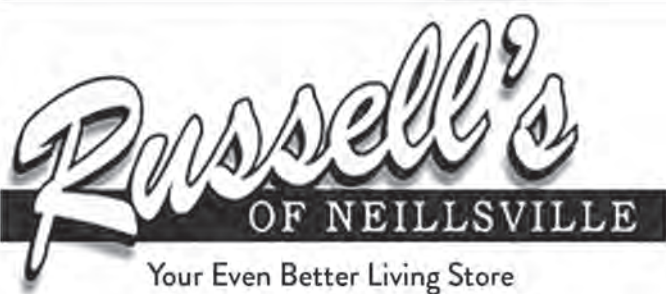

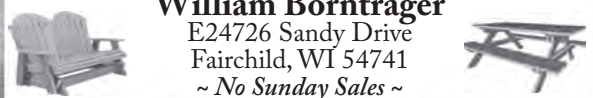

AND GOD SAYS . . .

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. Galatians 6:7

I heard of a man that was mocking an evangelist. The evangelist suddenly stopped preaching, pointed his finger directly at him, and said, "Will a man mock God?" And instantly, the man was flipped out of his seat and into the row behind him. From then on, the evangelist preached uninterrupted.

When we speak of mocking God, I think our minds automatically think of ridicule, like the man described above. Consequently, we believe that verse does not apply to us. But does it?

The American Heritage® Dictionary gives as it's third meaning, "To mimic or resemble closely." The Webster dictionary of 1828 says it means "False, counterfeit; assumed; imitating reality, but not real."

Do these definitions tend to hit us closer to home? I mean, are we like those Pharisees and teachers of the law whom Jesus rebuked in John 15? You see, they appeared to obey the law by professing to honor their father and mother, they justified themselves for not properly providing for them by claiming their money was devoted to God. Their lives actually appeared to be righteous, but in reality, Jesus used them as examples of self-centered lives that mocked God.

Charles G. Finney, a preacher in the 1800s, wrote about the effects of mocking God: "To mock God is to pretend to love and serve him when we do not; to act in a false manner." This is exactly what these Jewish leaders were doing.

But the biggest issue is not what the Jewish leaders were doing, but what we are doing? Are we doing the same thing? Like what justifications do we use for not becoming involved in a local church (Hebrews 10:25)? Or holding onto our bitterness toward others, being unwilling to forgive (Ephesians 4:32)? Or our complaining spirit (Philippians 2:14)? Or not keeping our word (Ecclesiastes 4:4-6)? Or lying (Colossians 3:9)? Or immodest dress (1 Timothy 2:9)? Or . . . ?

Galatians 6:8 says, "The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life."

God cannot be mocked or fooled. Our true allegiance will be exposed (Hebrews 4:13).

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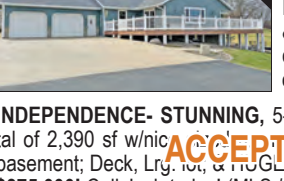
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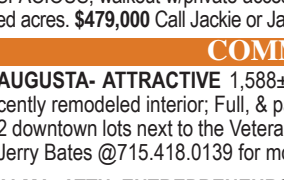

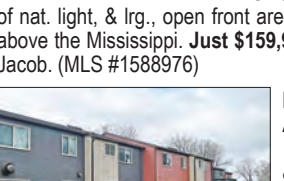
