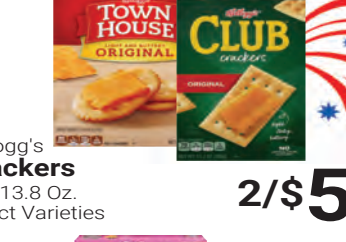

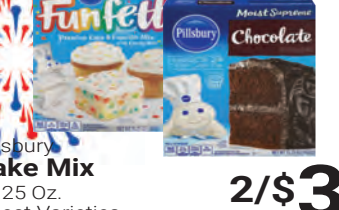

### Explaining the (Big, Beautiful) Bill

On May 22nd, Republicans in Congress passed a tax break for the ultrawealthy. Now the Senate will have to decide what to do. The bill is not popular: 60% of Americans think the bill will help rich people; 54% think it will hurt poor people.

The bill will change where the government spends its money, hurting the people who need the most help. The bill cuts **\$700 billion from Medicaid**, and **\$267 billion from SNAP**, the food stamp program. **Medicaid** is health insurance for low-income people who qualify. This includes low-income adults, children, pregnant women, elderly adults and people with disabilities. In Wisconsin it is called Badger Care. Medicaid provides benefits to cover nursing home and personal care services that a family could not afford to pay. Half of its funding is provided by the federal government which also sets minimum requirements for the program.

**This is how the cuts happen over time:**

- The government will pay states a fixed amount per person (rather than a percentage) leaving the difference to the state to pay, if they can afford it.
- The government will require more proof of eligibility and work requirements but will leave the cost of processing, enforcement and employment to the state. Those who can't keep up with the paperwork or miss deadlines will lose their health care.
- The government will lower what they pay the state for costs to run the program, process claims and stop fraud.

To keep the same level of health care access through Badger Care, Wisconsin will have to cut money from schools, roads or public safety. Or raise taxes.

**The money from Medicaid helps pay for nursing homes and rural hospitals.**

**If Medicaid pays less to those services, we risk losing them, too. (Your parents or grandparents can move in with you.)**

What the U.S. owes (deficit) will rise by over **2.4 TRILLION**. With interest, that increases to **3 TRILLION** over 10 years. We will have to borrow more money from the rich and from other countries through bonds. We will have to pay it back.

**So will our grandchildren. So will their grandchildren.**

**While these cuts are made to us and our families, the bill will allow the richest Americans to pay less in taxes. Much less.**

# AND GOD SAYS . . .

The coming of the lawless one will be in accordance with the work of Satan displayed in . . . every sort of evil that deceives those who are perishing. (2 Thessalonians 2:9-10 NIV)

See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ. (Colossians 2:8 NIV).

For example, the violation of the third and fourth commandments. Do you even know what they are? Do not use God’s name in vain and honor the Sabbath day to keep it holy. How many of us use the exclamation, “Oh, my God,” in vain — That is, without even thinking about it, in a meaningless, impotent way? And how many really keep the Lord’s day holy? (Note; I will save the discussion about whether we should worship on Saturday or Sunday as New Testament Christians for another day.)

Or how about truly honoring your mother and father on days other than Mother’s Day or Father’s Day? Or is your usual response to them one of resistance, complaint, or defiance against their authority? If these describe your behavior, you are being deceived by Satan who is subtly deceiving you and taking you captive.

You say, “Those are really small things and everybody does it.” That may be true, but first, it doesn’t make it right. And second, it is not a small thing with God. In fact, all Adam and Eve did was eat a piece of fruit that they weren’t supposed to and as a result, all their offspring and in fact, all of creation was impacted negatively. True worship of God is not singing songs of praise and then living by the standards of the world, but its being obedient to Jesus in our everyday life as we live by His standards according to His Word. This is true worship and pleasing to God.

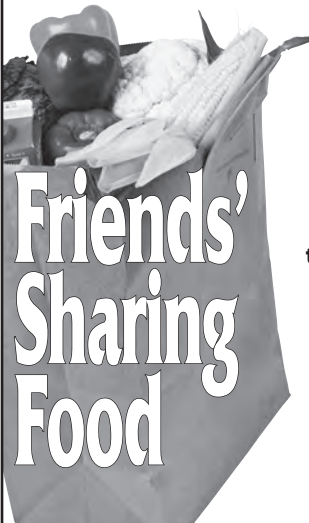
