WHY OBEY IN ADVANCE?

Timothy Snyder wrote an easy-to-read book titled *On Tyranny. Twenty Lessons from the Twentieth Century*. It is short but can keep you safe and thinking clearly in tough times. Snyder studied how dictators gain power and how people can stand up to them. The first lesson in his book is:

★ DO NOT OBEY IN ADVANCE.

Dictators often gain power because people give it to them. People and groups often guess what a dictator will want and then follow along without being asked.

We have seen examples now in the U.S.:

- Columbia University bent the knee to President Trump when he threatened to take their money unless they changed their rules and the courses they taught.

- Paul Weiss and 8 other large law firms quickly made deals with the President. They were afraid of losing government contracts. They agreed to give almost a billion dollars in free legal work to causes that Trump liked.

Unfortunately - just like with the school bully - once you give in, they want more.

Some groups said "no." Harvard University didn't give in. Other law firms resisted. Now they benefit from taking a stand.

People often try to stay safe by going along with power. But people will do more than comply. Dictators have been surprised at how easy a take-over can be when people rush to help. Hitler's path to power was made easier by the many people who quickly just obeyed.

Snyder says:

★ "A citizen who adapts in this way is teaching power what it can do."

Psychologists find people obey quickly when under pressure - even when it's against the person's beliefs.

★ Don't assume that you must comply. "Question Authority" Ask yourself, "is this the right thing to do?" or "I am afraid to resist - but can I at least do less?"

Dictators "move fast and break things" to shock and demoralize others.

They make others feel that dictatorship is inevitable.

Remember that nothing is inevitable.

You are not alone. Don't be afraid. Connect with others and find someone who is doing good work - and join them.

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AND GOD SAYS . . .

. . . you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of me . . . Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.  
(Matthew 24:9-14 NIV)

The news has been saturated by the coverage of the Texas flood, and rightly so. With almost 130 casualties and over 160 people missing, it is a tragedy of epic proportions. It is hard to imagine the grief so many people are experiencing in their sudden and unexpected loss.

But, while not wanting to diminish the importance of this story, I think it important to note that there are two other stories of greater loss of life that rarely get much coverage, except by special interest groups. Can you guess what stories these might be?

If you guessed world-wide Christian persecution and martyrdom as one of those stories, you would be correct. The fact is that the number of Christians killed in the 20th century is more that all the rest of Christian history combined. Records show that in the 21st century, roughly 100,000 to 160,000 Christians were killed each year. That means somewhere between 2 1/2 to 40 million Christians have been killed for their faith in the last 25 years. In comparison with the loss of life caused by the flood in Texas, it would seem that this story would be worthy of significantly more press.

The second story I am thinking of is the story of abortion. Since the late 70's there have been over a million babies killed almost every year, with the death toll reaching over a 1.5 million for most of those years (totaling over 60 million). Certainly, regardless of one's viewpoint, this should be worthy of a story or two.

Just think of the cost to our nation, from a practical and economic point of view, as a result of the loss of consumers to buy goods and the loss of laborers to manufacture them. Then add to this the moral implications of taking the lives of the innocent. It seems to me to be nearly impossible to measure the cost of this loss of life to our nation. Isn't it time for us to raise our voices in support of "life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness?"

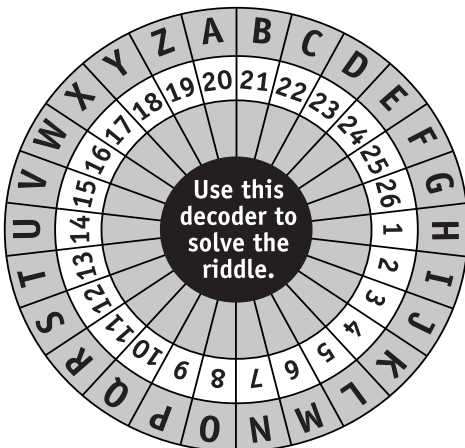

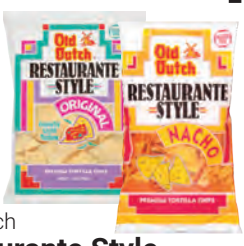
