 Panther Creek C&D, LLC.

Notice is hereby given that Panther Creek C&D, LLC. intends to construct a new construction and demolition (C&D) waste disposal facility located on property in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 25 North, Range 1 West in the Town of York, Clark County, Wisconsin. Access to the proposed facility will be from County Highway (CTH) H, approximately 0.9-mile west of the intersection of CTH K and CTH H.

The new facility will be designed in accordance with Wisconsin Administrative Code (WAC) NR 503.10 requirements which includes a 3-foot-thick compacted clay liner, leachate collection and extraction system, storm water management system, and environmental monitoring. The design capacity will be no more than 250,000 cubic yards and will accept only waste classified as C&D waste which includes concrete, brick, bituminous concrete, wood, glass, masonry, roofing, siding, plaster, and other related materials, alone or in combination. A plan of operation will be submitted to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for review and approval prior to construction and operation of the new facility.

The proposed operation will provide a competitively priced alternative for proper disposal of C&D waste. The disposal facility will accept waste through their C&D waste hauling subsidiary, and other contracted C&D waste haulers. The facility is anticipated to be in operation for approximately 15 years.
