

NOTICE CITY OF NEILLSVILLE TAXPAYERS

2022 TAX COLLECTION BEGINS Jan. 2, 2023 at the Office of the City Clerk-Treasurer.

THE OFFICE IS OPEN FOR TAX COLLECTION PURPOSES FROM 9 A.M. TO 4 P.M. WEEKDAYS CLOSED SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS PLEASE BRING YOUR TAX NOTICE WITH YOU TO AVOID DELAY.

TWO METHODS TO PAY REAL ESTATE TAXES:

1. Payment in full on or before January 31, 2023 Wis. Stats. 74.11 (2) (a).

IF THE TOTAL REAL PROPERTY TAX IS LESS THAN \$100, IT SHALL BE PAID IN FULL ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 31. Wis. Stats. 74.11 (5)

2. Payment in 2 equal installments (unless the total real property tax is less than \$100) as per Wis. Stats. 74.11 (2) (b):

FIRST INSTALLMENT is due on or before January 31, 2023 to the City Treasurer during above stated office hours.

SECOND INSTALLMENT shall be paid to the Clark County Treasurer on or before July 31, 2023 at the Courthouse, 517 Court Street, Neillsville, Wisconsin, 54456.

STATE LAW DOES NOT PERMIT TWO PAYMENT PLAN AFTER JANUARY 31, 2023.

ALL PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES, WIS. STATS. 74.11 (4), SHALL BE PAID IN FULL ON OR BEFORE FIVE WORKING DAYS AFTER JANUARY 31, 2023.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS, SPECIAL CHARGES AND OTHER SPECIAL TAXES, WIS. STATS. 74.11 (3) SHALL BE PAID IN FULL ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 31, 2023

All real property taxes, special assessments, special charges and special taxes that become delinquent shall be paid, together with interest and penalties charged from the preceding February 1, to the county treasurer. Wis. Stats. 74.11 (11) (a).

All personal property taxes that become delinquent shall be paid, together with interest and penalties charged from preceding February 1, to the CITY TREASURER. Wis. Stats. 74.11 (11) (b).

If payment from a taxpayer is received which is not sufficient to pay all general property taxes, special taxes due, the treasurer shall apply the payment to the amounts due, including interest and penalties, in the following order pursuant to Wis. Stats. 74.11 (12):

1. Personal property taxes.	4. Special assessments.
2. Delinquent utility charges.	5. Special taxes.
3. Special charges.	6. Real property taxes.

LOTTERY CREDIT

For qualified homeowners on your principal residence only. The credit amount will appear preprinted on the tax bill of all taxpayers who have timely filed the precertification form. However, in order to receive the full credit the parcel of land must have a value of \$27,900. Qualified owners whose property tax bill does not reflect a credit will be able to claim the credit by use of a late claim form through January 31, 2023.

**- ATTENTION -
DOG OWNERS**

The owner of a dog more than 5 months of age on January 1, of any year, or 5 months of age within the license year shall annually, or on or before the date the dog becomes 5 months of age pay the dog license tax and obtain a license. Wis. Stats. 174.05 (1).

The minimum dog license tax is \$3 for a neutered male dog or spayed female dog, upon presentation of evidence that the dog is neutered or spayed, and \$8 for an unneutered male dog or unspayed female dog.

No license will be issued without proof of rabies vaccination. Please bring or send copies of your veterinarian record showing vaccine brand name, serial number and expiration date.

Rabies vaccination required for all dogs within 30 days after the dog reaches 4 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Wis. Stats. 95.21 (2).

KEEPING OF DANGEROUS ANIMALS PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful to keep, harbor, own or any way possess within the corportate limits of the City of Neillsville:

(1) Any warm-blooded, carnivorous or omnivorous, wild or exotic animal including but not limited to non-human primates, raccoons, skunks, foxes and wild and exotic cats.

(2) Any animal having venomous/poisonous bites.

(3) Any animal that has previously been declared as a dangerous animal by another entity.

City code ordinance Section 7-1-5(a).

LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF DOGS

No person or family shall own, harbor, or keep in its possession more than a total of three (3) dogs in any residential unity (except those grandfathered on the effective date of the ordinance). City code ordinances Section 7-1-6(e)(1).
