Main Street (County K) Sidewalk Project to be discussed at January 14, 2026 Public Involvement Meeting located at Village of Granton Fire Station

Information for the planned new sidewalk along Main Street/County K from the Granton C-Store to East 5th Street and along Granton Road to the Dollar General will be presented. Improvements to the County K/ Granton Road/Romadka Avenue intersection under a separate project will also be discussed. This project is located in Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, T-24-N, R-1-W, Village of Granton, Clark County, and will be discussed at a public involvement meeting on January 14, 2026, the Village of Granton announced today.

The meeting will be held from 5:00 – 6:00 PM at the Village of Granton Fire Station, 21 S Main Street, Granton, WI 54436.

The purpose of the project is to provide a route for pedestrians between businesses on the south side of the Village of Granton and downtown Granton, connecting to sidewalk constructed during the 2024 Main Street construction project. The Village of Granton is proposing a new sidewalk along Main Street/County K, beginning at the Granton Convenience Store and connecting to existing sidewalk at East 5th Street and along Granton Road from the proposed sidewalk on County K to the Dollar General. The proposed side-

walk would include the construction of curb ramps meeting ADA design standards. Right of way impacts will include both permanent and temporary limited easements for driveway reconstruction and grading. County K will remain open during construction of the sidewalk. Construction is scheduled for the 2027 construction season.

The sidewalk project is being administered through the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) with involvement from Wisconsin Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration.

A separate project is proposed to improve the County K/Granton Road/Romadka Avenue intersection to a 4-way stop to improve vehicle movements, improve safety, and provide pedestrian crossing locations. Construction for this project is currently scheduled for the 2026 construction season.

The January 14, 2026 meeting will begin with a short presentation at 5:00 PM followed by an open house format with a variety of exhibits and maps available for review. Representatives from Jewell Associates Engineers, Inc. will be on hand to answer questions throughout the meeting. Attendees will have the option of making written or verbal comments during the gathering.
