Village of Granton Clark County, Wisconsin

Purpose, the Village Board of Granton deems it necessary to regulate the use of Shipping Containers and Trailers within the Village of Granton.

Authority, The Village of Granton has the authority to, pursuant to Section 60.10(2), 60.21(2) & 61.34(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, to enact this ordinance.

Section 1. Definitions

- (1) "Shipping Container" means any shipping container, cargo container, portable on demand storage (PODS), store and move (SAM) container and similar unit with or without axles and wheels.
(2) "Trailer" means a trailer manufactured primarily for the conveyance of goods and property with or without axles and wheels.
(3) "Residential Use" refers to property within the Village that contains a single-family home or multi-family home intended for human habitation.
(4) "Non-Residential Use" refers to property within the Village used for commercial, industrial, agricultural, or other non-residential purposes.

A. Prohibition. No person shall place, cause to be placed, use, or permit the use of any shipping container or trailer to be used for any type of human occupancy on any residentially zoned land or any property the primary use of which is residential.

B. Exceptions. The Village of Granton, Granton Area Fire Department or Emergency related service is excluded from this ordinance.

Section 2. Residential Use Regulations

- The use of Storage Containers is allowed for residential use provided that the conditions listed hereunder are met.
A. No more than one (1) shipping container or trailer shall be permitted per residential property.
B. All shipping containers shall be painted or finished in a manner that reasonably matches or complements the primary residence on the property.
C. All containers and trailers shall comply with applicable Village building regulations.

Section 3. Non-Residential Use

The use of Storage Containers is allowed for non-residential use provided that the conditions listed hereunder are met.
A. All containers and trailers shall comply with applicable Village building regulations

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect the day after posting.
