Receiving Water And Location: the Black River and the groundwaters of the Cawley and Rock Creeks Watershed of the Black-Buffalo-Trempealeau River Basin in Clark County
Brief Facility Description and Summary of Proposed Changes: Grassland Dairy Products, located in Greenwood, WI produces butter and condensed buttermilk, dried butter milk, dried milk powder and condensed skim milk. The annual average design flow of the facility is 0.8 million gallons per day (MGD) and in 2022 the actual annual average effluent flow was 0.39 MGD. Sanitary waste and process wastewater, including condensate of whey (COW) water, blower blowdown, cooling tower blowdown and non-contact cooling water (NCCW), are treated via a high strength side stream to the anaerobic digester with solids separation through UF membranes. Permeate combines with low-strength influent which then goes through the aeration system, is biologically treated for phosphorus, solids are then separated through gravity clarification/UF membrane, concentrate as RAS and permeate is chemically treated for phosphorus using aluminum sulfate. Effluent is disinfected seasonally using ultraviolet disinfection and then discharged to the Black River. Sludge is thickened in a dissolved air flotation (DAF) thickener and then sent to sludge storage. The facility uses biological and chemical treatment for the removal of phosphorus. Sludge generated during the treatment process is recycled via landspreading on DNR approved agricultural fields. Operational changes during the last permit term include the installation of a side stream anaerobic digester. Significant effluent monitoring and/or limit changes proposed in the upcoming permit term are as follows: 1) the addition of quarterly monitoring for total Kjeldahl nitrogen, nitrate + nitrite nitrogen and total nitrogen, 2) a slight reduction in the chronic WET limit, 3) the addition of ammonia limits & a dissolved oxygen (DO) limit, and a schedule to meet the DO limit 4) a slight reduction in the 6 month average phosphorus mass limit, 5) fecal coliform monitoring and limits have been replaced with Escherichia coli (E. coli) monitoring and limits, 6) a reduction in the daily max total suspended solids mass limit, 7) removal of the chlorine limit & monitoring because the permittee no longer uses chlorine to control filamentous microorganisms in the wastewater, 8) an increase in the frequency of acute and chronic WET tests, 9) the expansion of the variable seasonal effluent ammonia daily maximum limits to include applicable limits at a lower effluent pH. To quantitate the risk, PFAS sludge sampling has been included in the permit pursuant to ss. NR 214.18(5)(b) and NR 204.06(2)(b)9., Wis. Adm. Code. A schedule is included in the permit that requires the permittee submit updated land application management plan.

The Department has tentatively decided that the above-specified WPDES permit should be reissued.
Limitations and conditions which the Department believes adequately protect the receiving water are included in the proposed permit. Land application of waste shall be done in accordance with permit conditions and applicable codes. All land application sites shall be approved prior to their use. To receive a list of approved sites, or to be notified of potential approvals, contact the above-named basin engineer.
Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed permit action, or to request a public hearing, may write to the Department of Natural Resources at the above-named permit drafter's address. All comments or suggestions received no later than 30 days after the publication date of this public notice will be considered along with other information on file in making a final decision regarding the permit. Anyone providing comments in response to this public notice will receive a notification of the Department's final decision when the permit is issued. Where designated as a reviewable surface water discharge permit, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is allowed up to 90 days to submit comments or objections regarding this permit determination. If no comments are received on the proposed permit from anyone, including U.S. EPA, the permit will be issued as proposed.
The Department may schedule a public informational hearing if requested by any person and shall schedule a public informational hearing if a petition requesting a hearing is received from 5 or more persons or if response to this notice indicates significant public interest pursuant to s. 283.49, Wis. Stats. Requests for a public informational hearing shall state the following: the name and address of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the interest in the proposed permit of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the reasons for the request; and the issues proposed to be considered at

the hearing.
Information on file for this permit action, including the draft permit, fact sheet and permit application, may be inspected and copied at either the above-named permit drafter's office or the above named basin engineer's office, Monday through Friday (except holidays), between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please call the permit drafter or basin engineer for directions to their office location, if necessary. The project consists of the replacement of two (2) steam boilers that serve air handling units and terminal devices throughout portions of the facility. There are four (4) steam to hot water converters that will be replaced and piped to the new hot water boiler systems. The existing system will be split into two (2) new separate boiler plants with equal output of the removed boilers.
