VILLAGE OF GRANTON
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Village of Granton will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, October 8, 2025, at 5:30 pm. The public hearing location will be the Village Hall, located at 117 Maple Street, Granton, WI 54436. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive public comments on the Facility Plan: Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) Facility Improvements prepared by Cedar Corporation and the Village of Granton. A copy of the Facility Plan will be available for review at the Village Hall, located at 117 Maple Street, Granton, WI 54436.

The Facility Plan was developed to assess the scope and feasibility of various upgrade and improvement alternatives for the Village's wastewater treatment plant. Its primary objectives are to ensure the continued provision of reliable wastewater treatment over the 20-year design horizon and to maintain compliance with the Village's Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) permit. This includes addressing regulatory requirements related to the new E. coli compliance schedule. The Village's chemical feed system for phosphorus needs full inspection and equipment improvements. The current system is part of an extended pilot study and lacks permanent equipment

necessary for safe and reliable treatment of wastewater. Additionally, a dedicated disinfection system is needed at the treatment plant to enable discharging of wastewater year-round. Finally, miscellaneous improvements related to the infrastructure of the WWTP are needed to ensure reliable treatment for the 20-year design period.

The alternatives identified in the Facility Plan address solutions to add a permanent chemical feed system, dedicated disinfection system, and miscellaneous infrastructure improvements.

The selected alternative for wastewater treatment plant upgrades includes the installation of a permanent chemical feed system, retrofitting the existing chlorine contact chamber to house a UV disinfection system, and miscellaneous infrastructure improvements. Included in these miscellaneous improvements are blower building roof upgrade, electrical system improvements, valve replacement, aeration system upgrades, septage receiving station, generator installation, and effluent flow meter replacement. The estimated cost for the project is \$2,978,000. Construction for the project is tentatively scheduled to begin in the spring of 2027 with completion in September 2028. The project will be financed through the Village of Granton and through a low interest loan from the State of Wisconsin Clean Water Fund. To pay for the project, Village sewer user

rates will be increased. Anticipated sewer user impacts will be discussed as part of the Public Hearing.
