**AMENDED PLAINTIFF’S NOTICE OF MOTION
AND MOTION TO TURN OVER COLLATERAL OR
OTHERWISE FOR CONTEMPT OF COURT ORDER**

Plaintiff, Stellantis Financial Services, Inc. (“Stel-
lantis”) by their attorneys, Galanis, Pollack, Jacobs &
Johnson, SC hereby moves the Court, the Honorable
William Bratcher, or other assigned judge, presiding in
their courtroom at the Clark County Courthouse, 517
Court St, Neillsville, WI 54456 **on AUGUST 31, 2026
at 10:30 A.M.** for an Order finding the defendant in
contempt of court if the defendant fails to turn the col-
lateral over to the plaintiff.

The previously scheduled motion for contempt on
July 28, 2026 at 10:00 AM has been approved for ad-
journment for service of process by publication and
mailing for the new date.

On June 24, 2025 the Plaintiff was awarded a judg-
ment against the defendant for the return of the fol-
lowing collateral: **2024 Ram 2500 – VIN: 3C6UR5C-
J8RG171295.**

1. The defendant has not made the 2024 Ram 2500
available and the failure to make the collateral avail-
able to the plaintiff is merits for this court to issue an
order for contempt.

2. The defendant’s failure to make the collateral
available to the Sheriff when enforcing a writ of replev-
in is merits for this court to issue an order for contempt.
That included with this motion is the sheriff report in-
dicating collateral could not be located as claiming to
payoff the plaintiff and or sold the vehicle. The claimed
payoff was already litigated in this case and no pay-
ment of valid funds was ever conveyed. The plaintiff’s
security interest was never released and any sale
would be subject to said secured interest.

3. Despite that statement of transfer of secured col-
lateral to a third party. GPS coordinates for the vehicle
indicate it is located at N16209 Bruce Mound Avenue,
Thorp, Wisconsin 54771.

4. It is the plaintiff’s position that the collateral re-
mains concealed at N16209 Bruce Mound Avenue,
Thorp, Wisconsin 54771 as that was the last known
address for the GPS Tracking coordinate and defen-
dant remains at that same address. That if a search
and seizure warrant is required, the plaintiff will sepa-
rately so move.

5. Wisconsin Statute §943.84(2) indicates that
the defendant cannot conceal, remove or transfer
property with a security interest:

- 943.84 Transfer of encumbered property.
(2) Whoever, with intent to defraud, does any
of the following may be penalized as provided
in s. 943.91:
(a) Conceals, removes or transfers any per-
sonal property in which he or she knows an-
other has a security interest; or
(b) In violation of the security agreement, fails
or refuses to pay over to the secured party the
proceeds from the sale of property subject to a
security interest.

6. There is no dispute that the plaintiff has a security
interest in the collateral and further, there can be no
dispute that the defendant is concealing, removed and
transferred the property.

7. Whereby the plaintiff will agree to allow the de-
fendant seven (7) days to provide the property to the
Plaintiff, or otherwise stay enforcement of an Order for
Contempt.

8. Plaintiff’s position being that if the defendant fails
to return the collateral in that timeline, that an Order for
Contempt would be appropriate.

WHEREFORE: Stellantis Financial Services, Inc.
requests the Court enter an Order holding Ralph E.
Steiner in contempt, actual attorney’s fees and costs in
filing this motion, and for such other relief as this Court
deems just and proper.
